### **NATURE OF WORK:**

To provide professional and efficient law enforcement service to the citizens of Cumberland County. These duties are performed in accordance with the Constitution of the United States and the State of North Carolina, State Laws, County Ordinances, and the Rules, Regulations and Procedures of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office. The employee is expected to exercise independent judgement and discretion in the performance of his/her duties. Considerable tact, firmness, compassion and common sense are required in the enforcement of the law, and when in contact with the public. Performs related work as required. Employee is subject to the hazards and mental stress that is congruous to this profession. The duties include, but are not limited to: patrolling by bike, vehicle or foot any assigned area of the county; inspect troublesome areas and check security of business establishments; answer complaint calls and assist in investigating crimes and disturbances.
