

ELECTRONIC FILING FOR 50-B DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIVE ORDERS

Did you know that you can file your 50-B Civil Domestic Violence Order lawsuit and process your emergency request without coming to the Cumberland County Courthouse?

Victims can complete and file an order of protection and have the case heard before a judge via video-conference at all three locations. Electronic filing for domestic violence protective orders offers victims a safe and confidential environment outside of the courthouse to file for a protective order with the assistance of a trained advocate. Offering this option provides victims the opportunity to have immediate access to the full continuum of additional services such as counseling, safety planning, shelter, legal referrals and case management.

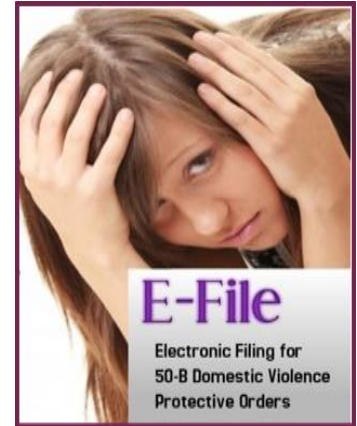

50B Protection Order

You can file for this type of protective order if you and the person you are filing against:

- ◇ Are current or former spouses
- ◇ Are persons of the opposite sex who currently live together or have lived together in a domestic relationship
- ◇ Is your child, a parent, grandchild or grandparent
- ◇ Have a child in common
- ◇ Are current or former household members
- ◇ Are persons of the opposite sex who are currently dating or have been in a dating relationship
